- **Dates:** (including travel days): March 10th (arrival) to March 15th (departure), 2013
- **Place:** Bad Dürkheim, Rheinland-Pfalz, Germany (close to Mannheim, Frankfurt)
- **Participants:** About 50 participants from 30 Roma and non-Roma youth organizations
- **Participants Registration Deadline:** February 8th, 2013
- **Confirmation of participants:** February 10th, 2013

Registration: deadline February 8th, 2013

Please send us the applications of your organization's participant/s by February 8th. You will then receive immediately a confirmation. Please wait for our confirmation until you book the tickets.

Costs of participants: 30 % of travel costs (based on the Youth in Action rules)

The participants have to book their travel themselves after their participation was confirmed. 70 % of travel costs will be refunded by the organizers (preferably bank account to the organization, for cash contact us before). You can go by train, bus or flight; for the exception of using a car, please contact us before. For other doubts, contact us! ☺

Closest airports:

- Frankfurt/Main (main international airport in Germany, from there the train takes 30 minutes to Mannheim, cost of train: 24,50 € one way)
- Frankfurt/Hahn (main Ryan Air/cheap flight airport, about 3h trip with bus/train (costs 35€), but maybe some other pick-up can be organized, depending on the arrivals)
- Karlsruhe-Baden (Ryan Air/cheap flight airport, about 2h trip with train (costs 18 €))
- Stuttgart Airport (S-Bahn, train: 1,5-2 hours; 30-40 €, 2-3 hours: 30 €)

Closest train station and pick-up: From **Mannheim** you will be picked up from our logistic team.
